W: If your dog looks sick, these simple tests will help you find out whether your dog is really sick or not. Pull your dog's lip up and look at its gums. They should be a mild pink. Excessively red gums can indicate a high body temperature or gum disease. Pale gums indicate weakness or poor blood flow from low blood pressure. Yellow gums suggest liver problems. You can also do a simple test. Find an area of pink gum and press your finger on it to turn it white. Remove your finger and count how many seconds it takes for the color to come back. Normally, it takes less than two seconds. If it takes longer, circulation is poor. This can indicate heart disease. So, if you see any of these signs, you should take your dog to a veterinarian.


